Types of events offered in cooperation with and under the label of the European Choral Association

All events promoted by the European Choral Association including those published in this brochure are based on the following principles:

- events for choirs and singers, vocal leaders/conductors, creators/composers, educators/teachers and managers, organised by the European Choral Association or in partnership are non-competitive (except for competitions for conductors and composers). Among the activities promoted there can be special competitions or educational offers in relation to competitions, especially if the organisers are members of the Choral Festival Network.
- all events have an educational aspect (which can be a training course, workshops, choir-to-choir concerts, Open Singing or other elements which help participants improve their level of knowledge).
- all events are international, welcoming participants from outside the host country and providing information and activities in English for an important part of the programme.

There are three basic types of events published under the label of the European Choral Association:

1. Cooperation Events of the European Choral Association



These events are designed by European Choral Association and travel between different countries. They have a typical structure which remains the same with some aspects adapted each time. The European Choral Association is involved in the artistic design and the most important decision-making processes and the participation fees include reduced fees for indirect members of European Choral Association as well as for participants from specific country groups (European Choral Association fee system based on a solidarity principle):

- EUROPA CANTAT festival
- EUROPA CANTAT junior
- Leading Voices
- FuroChoir
- World Youth Choir
- Workshops in connection with Membership weekends of the European Choral Association
- Activities offered in the frame of specific EU-funded projects such as capacitybuilding workshops, webinars, grant schemes etc.



2. Events under the Label of the European Choral Association



Events for choirs and singers, vocal leaders/ conductors, creators/composers, educators/ teachers and/or choral lovers, with differing and flexible structure and programmes. The artistic programme is developed in partnership with the European Choral Association and the participation fees are based on the European Choral Association system (see above).

3. Events from the International Choral Sector

Different types of international choral events organised by partner organisations or organisations in which the European Choral Association is a member, and which follow the three principles described above. The concept, structure and artistic programme are developed by the local organisers alone and the European Choral Association has no responsibility for the quality of these events.



IGNITE – IGNiting an Inclusive and sustainable future for collective singing Throughout Europe is a project of the European Choral Association, dealing with collective singing at the heart of the revitalisation of post-pandemic Europe, due to its effects on the health and wellbeing of the individual and society. It will benefit more than 100 organisations and thousands of individuals in most countries of the European Union, other Creative Europe programme countries and beyond.







Through the project, we will be able to:

- offer Membership Weekends (project milestones) and online gatherings;
- enhance youth participation and peer-to-peer exchange;
- grow the network with a regional strategy;
- hold physical and online training on environmental issues, inclusion, gender equality, fair remuneration and digital tools;
- disseminate guidelines and handbooks on these topics;
- offer grants for the internationalisation & inclusivity of events;
- collect and disseminate data on collective singing in Europe;



PEER-TO-PEER TRAINING

Financial support for your learning opportunities

The European Choral Association offers financial support for setting up international peerto-peer trainings and learning opportunities in the field of collective singing.

This programme offers participants the chance to spend some days learning from each other, sharing experiences, enlarging their networks and getting an insight into a foreign (work) culture.





Eligible peer-to-peer training projects may include learning opportunities for conductors, choirs, staff of choral organisations, board or youth committee members, etc.

Funding Conditions:

- At least one of the parties must be a representative of a member organisation
 or an indirect member of the European Choral Association (a member of a member organisation or a member of the Friends of the European Choral Association)
 or be based in one of the target countries of our Regional Development Strategy
- It's an international exchange with an educational aspect for which no party involved receives payment
- It has to be organised by the participating parties themselves the European Choral Association cannot organise such exchanges
- Funding will cover travel costs up to 300€
- Funding will cover accommodation and meals for up to five days (four nights) based on maximum flatrates

GRANTS FOR INTERNATIONALISATION AND INCLUSION

In the frame of the the IGNITE project, the European Choral Association will offer grants to organisations holding choral events, which are looking to:

- attract an international audience, or
- make their events more inclusive.

The aim is to help organisers cover additional costs connected to the internationalisation or greater inclusivity of their events.



Funding Conditions:

- All organisations organising relevant events will be eligible to apply. It will not be a requirement to be a member of the European Choral Association
- Physical persons are not eligible for this call
- The call is open to events taking place in Europe and organised by European organisations (by Europe, we mean Europe in the broadest sense)
- Events may be online, physical or hybrid and must involve training
- Concerts and competitions are not eligible

A maximum of 2000 € will be granted per event.

Deadline: The new call will be published in September 2023

and will be open until the end of October 2023




